



Troop 112 Statement on Youth Protection & Safe Haven

The primary goal of Troop 112 is to provide a safe and engaging program for our youth. We strive to ensure that our adult leaders are of good character and provide them with the appropriate training to support their best efforts in contributing to the growth and vibrancy of the troop. All adults must complete a Youth Protection course every two years in order to gain and continue membership. All adult leaders provide references and submit to a background check when applying for membership. It is the policy of the Boy Scouts of America that trips and outings may never be lead by one adult. At least two registered adult leaders are required for all trips and outings.

Any behavior during Troop activities that manifests itself as a distraction to the mission of Scouting, whether personal, political, or social, will not be tolerated. Adults as well as youth who engage in behavior that is inappropriate in a Scout setting will be disciplined.
